- where to find resources to support your organization.



Pass this on to anyone you know who may be interested. If you operate a maritime radio, you **must** have a Restricted Operator Certificate - Maritime (ROC-M) with DSC Endorsement. It's the law.

Please register at least 2 weeks ahead in order to get your course materials to review and learn the phonetic alphabet prior to the seminar.
