Weather cooperated beautifuly this year. Kids were swimming, and sunglasses were required. Our commander Ford grilled up some delectable eats, and a good time was had by all.


Carol and Ron (although a bit late) made a dazzling entrance by 'buzzing' the beach with their flying boat from the back side of the island.


